Subjects in demand	Economics, French, German (as a Foreign Language), all Natural Sciences, Physical Education
Subjects in which interns cannot be supervised	Ethics, Geography, Religion, Russian, Social Sciences Many Finnish teacher trainees in subjects like History and English: Students from Jena could only be placed in these subjects in case of free places on a very short notice (one or two months before the internship starts)
Registration for a practical semester at the University of Jena	15-31 October for a practical semester in the following school year
Internship starts from	Approx. mid August (beginning of 1 st of 5 periods/year of 8 weeks each) Beginning of January (middle of 3 rd period) or approx. mid February (beginning of 4 th period)
Application deadline at the school	Please apply at least one month before the deadline for submission of the internship confirmation in Jena (31 January/ 31 May). Only in the case of the above-mentioned subjects in demand the school will be able to confirm your internship place several months before the start of the internship.

The interns are responsible for the following points in particular	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ the procurement of bus/train or flight tickets▪ taking out the necessary insurance, e.g. foreign health, liability or cancellation insurance▪ obtaining a certificate of good conduct from the police▪ presentation of a certificate of enrolment▪ notification to the University of Jena (Internship Office/Centre for Teacher Training and Educational Research) if difficulties with the partner school or other circumstances lead to the internship not taking place or being terminated prematurely. <p>Interns undertake the journey to and stay in the destination country at their own risk.
